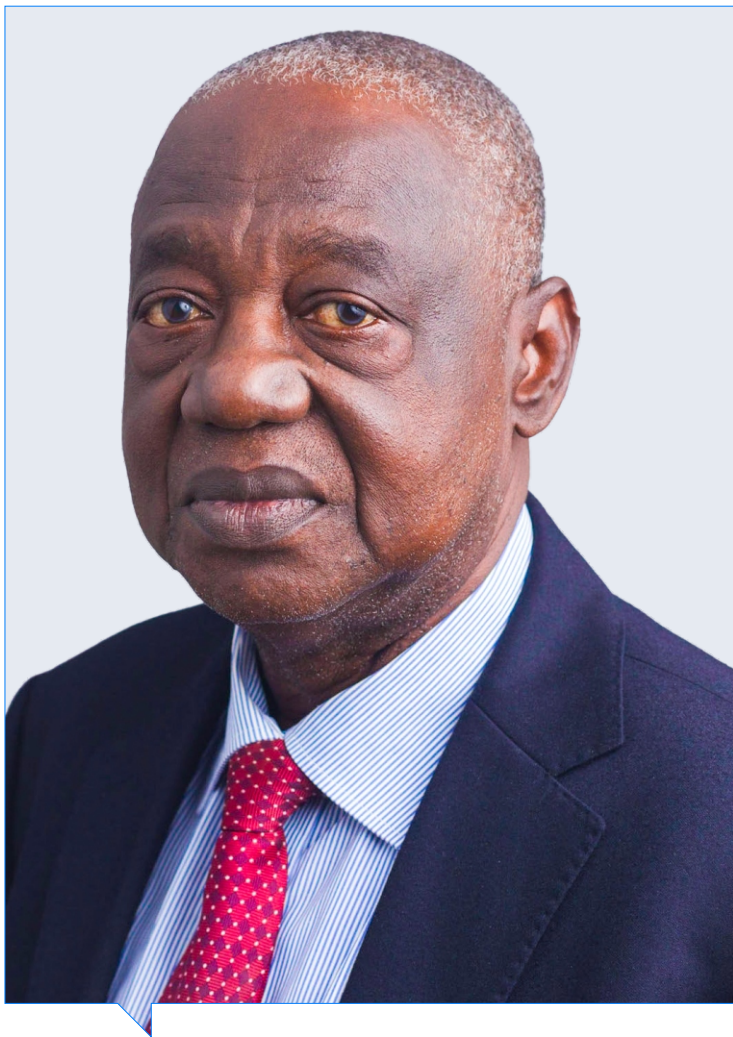

Opening Greeting

1. Steve Jobs’ Three Lessons

life only makes sense when we look backwards. The struggles, the confusion, the unexpected detours, they are all part of a greater design. His second, love and loss, teaches us that passion must persist even when things fall apart. Jobs was fired from his own company, yet that loss birthed new creations, NeXT and Pixar, and ultimately, his return to Apple. Likewise, we too have faced setbacks, but each one pushed us toward growth and self-discovery. And finally, facing death, perhaps the most sobering of all. Jobs once said, “If you live each day as if it were your last, someday you’ll most certainly be right.” It is a reminder that time is limited and that we must use it meaningfully to live, love, and lead with purpose.
